This workshop for instrumentalists and vocalists will teach the fundamentals of ensemble playing within the context of Afro-Cuban rhythms, Salsa and Latin Jazz. Open to intermediate to advanced level players of any instrument as well vocalists. Students must be proficient on their instrument/voice and be able to read music. All students will be encouraged to play percussion instruments, sing and dance!

Rhythmical styles to be explored include son-montuno, cha-cha-cha,

guaracha, bolero, 6/8 and others. Maximum of 15 students.

Latin jazz & World music powerhouse pianist, composer, arranger, author & educator. Mauleon has performed with Carlos Santana, Mickey Hart, Tito Puente & as leader of her own ensembles. Rebeca is an energetic, teacher & clinician who is in high demand internationally. She is the author of several major texts on Latin Music technique, including the *Salsa Guide Book*. Rebeca is the professor of Latin American Music at the City College of San Francisco and a guest Lecturer at U.C. Berkeley. (www.rebecamauleon.com)
